It will be the usual attendees those names that you have already to attend the Cabinet Committee meeting for the Deputation.

Sorry for the delay in getting this to you; re the "couple of paragraphs" needed, may I suggest the following:

"Summary deputation request to cabinet 7 June 2016 ALAG requests to be heard on:

- - item 11 on the agenda, with particular regard to consultation with leaseholders on details of the arbitration/mediation route proposed for valuations;
- - progress towards obtaining a response to our e-mail to Cllrs Williams and Livingstone of 9 March 2016 (annexed as "Deputation submission for cabinet 15 March 2016" to our submission for this meeting) on the points still needing to be addressed.

We ask cabinet to note that the reason for refusal of the deputation on 15 March was that a reply to the above should be the next step. No reply has been received. We therefore submit that receipt of the deputation would now be appropriate. We would suggest that cabinet considers clearly instructing officers and relevant cabinet members to put in place an on-going mechanism for ensuring that the concerns and suggestions of ALAG, and any other leaseholders' groups, are addressed promptly and efficiently, and for consultation on proposals by the council and/or Notting Hill Housing Trust which are likely to affect leaseholders."
